

Colorado Capitol Watch Bill Tracker: Portrait Format

This document explains how to select and order fields commonly used for the portrait bill tracker.

Step 1: Confirm that you are working in the correct profile.

Step 2: Navigate to the Manage Your Profiles page. You can get there from the link on the lefthand navigation panel.

Step 3: Click on the Select fields (portrait format) link.

Manage your Profiles
Set up your tools here to watch legislators, bills, and issues. After you select your bills and legislators, you can go to "Vote Watch" (in the left navigation) to track and analyze your selected legislators' votes.

Select your Current Profile. Add, Edit, and Delete Profiles.
NOTE: All "Reports based on Your Profile" are based on your Current Profile.

Manage Bills in your selected Profile
Add, remove, and configure bills in your selected Profile. Selected bills will appear in your Profile reports.

Manage Legislators in your selected Profile
Add, remove, and configure legislators in your selected profile. Selected legislators will appear in your Profile reports.

Enable/Manage Candidates in your selected Profile
Add, remove, and configure candidates in your selected profile. Selected candidates will appear in your Candidate reports.

Enable Lobbyist Searches and Reports
Search and report on bill lobbyists and their clients. This data is mirrored from the Secretary of State.

Description	Concerning creation of the agriculture and drought resiliency fund, and, in connection therewith, transferring money from the general fund to the fund and making an appropriation.
Summary	<p>The bill creates the agriculture and drought resiliency fund and directs the state treasurer to transfer \$3 million from the general fund to the fund. The department of agriculture will use the fund to engage in activities that promote the ability of the state to anticipate, prepare for, mitigate, adapt to, or respond to any event, trend, or climatological disturbance related to drought or climate. The fund is repealed, effective September 1, 2022.</p>

Title:	Stimulus Funding Department Of Agriculture Efficiency Programs
Position	Support
Comment	
Description	Concerning additional funding for programs of the department of agriculture to support increased efficiency in agricultural operations, and, in connection therewith, making an appropriation.
Summary	<p>The bill directs the state treasurer to make an immediate, one-time transfer of \$3 million from the general fund to the agriculture value-added cash fund to augment the department of agriculture's ongoing advancing Colorado's renewable energy and energy efficiency (ACRE3) program. The bill also appropriates \$2 million from the general fund to the conservation services division within the department of agriculture for the purpose of administering voluntary soil health programs. The bill requires the department of agriculture to periodically report on its expenditures to the office of state planning and budgeting and the general assembly.</p>
